GREECE



SKIATHOS AND SKOPELOS

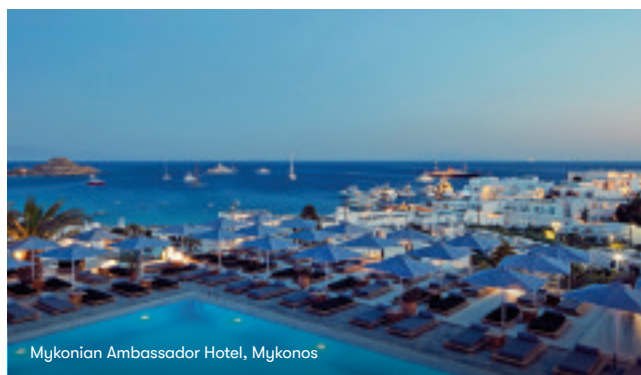

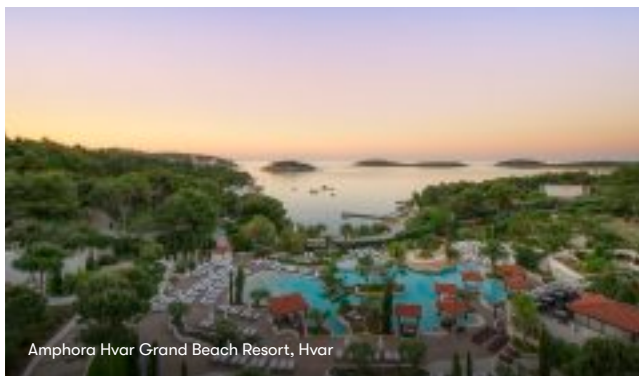

ITALY AND CROATIA

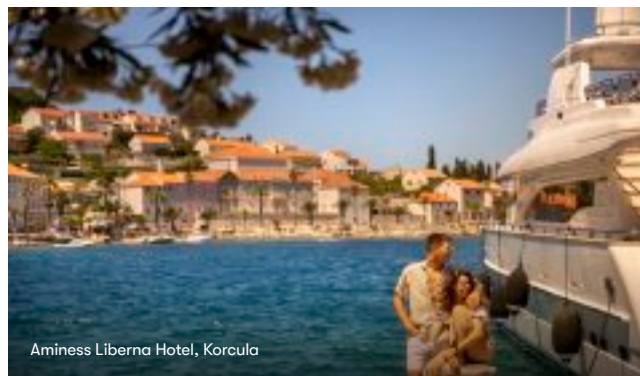

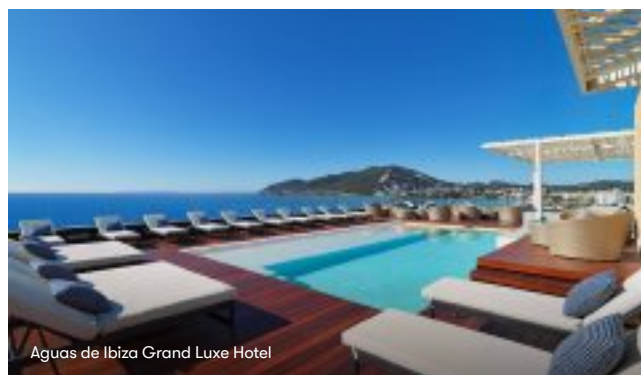
FUERTEVENTURA AND LANZAROTE

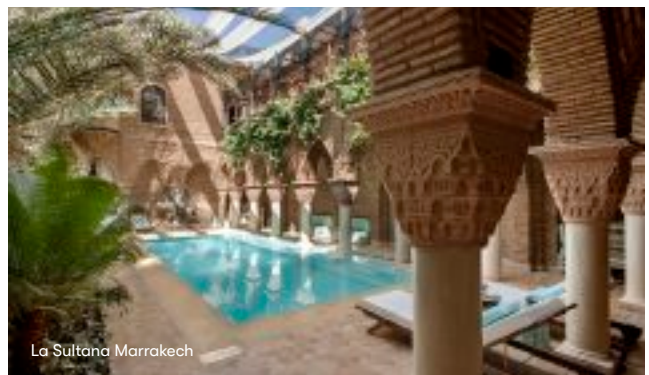

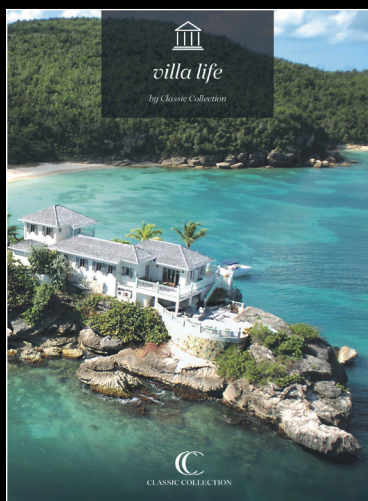
THAILAND, BANGKOK AND KRABI
